Special Meeting:

This Special Meeting was called to provide business owners and tenants the opportunity to hear about the proposed replacement of Pump Station 137 (located down the dirt road close to the Langley Speedway) and to provide any comments and feedback to the City of Hampton about the project.

At the meeting Dan Girouard, Asset Manager for the City of Hampton, stated that a new pump station is proposed on the site of Praxair and that the pump is being upsized to handle the new HRSD pressures in the force main.

Donald James from AES Consulting Engineers presented an overview of the proposed pump station project and answered questions from the meeting attendees.

No opposition to the proposed project was voiced by the attendees. As a follow-up to the meeting, Brian Wachter drafted a letter of support for the project on behalf of the Langley R&D Park Business Association, with the letter intended to be presented at a City Council meeting on the proposed project.
